FAMILIES FIRST

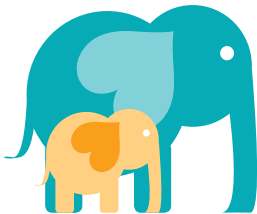
Families first provided support and guidance to 466 families (1,864 individuals) and served families in every county in Utah for the first time in the program's history.

A recent independent empirical study showed that the youth in families referred to Families First by the Juvenile Court committed 55% fewer felonies and misdemeanors than comparison youth.



ALPINE ACADEMY

The new Lakeview Campus for boys opened its doors to our first youth in July of 2020. The new campus is quickly rounding into shape and progress includes two family homes, indoor riding arena, soccer field, several landscape additions and exterior of the academic building.



SMARTER PARENTING

Online resources including podcasts, YouTube tutorials and resources included on the Smarter Parenting website provided parents around the world with over 559,411 engaged user interactions.

Parents from the USA, India, Australia, Mexico, Sweden and many other countries spent over 115,221 hours learning concrete parenting skills.

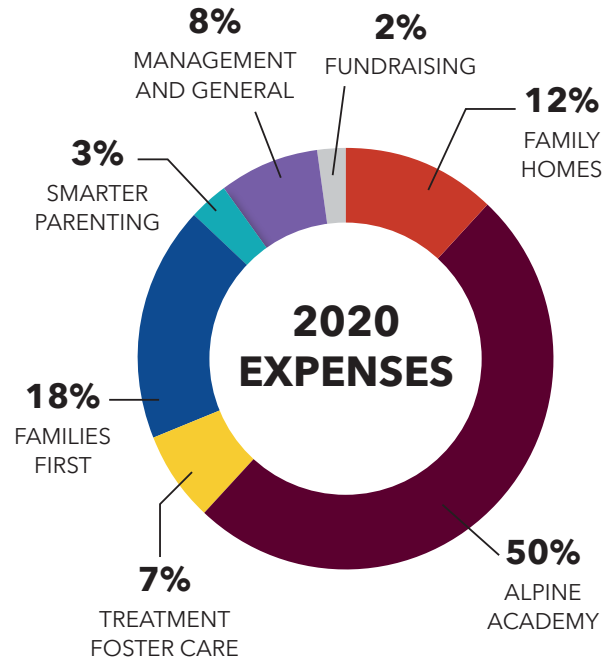
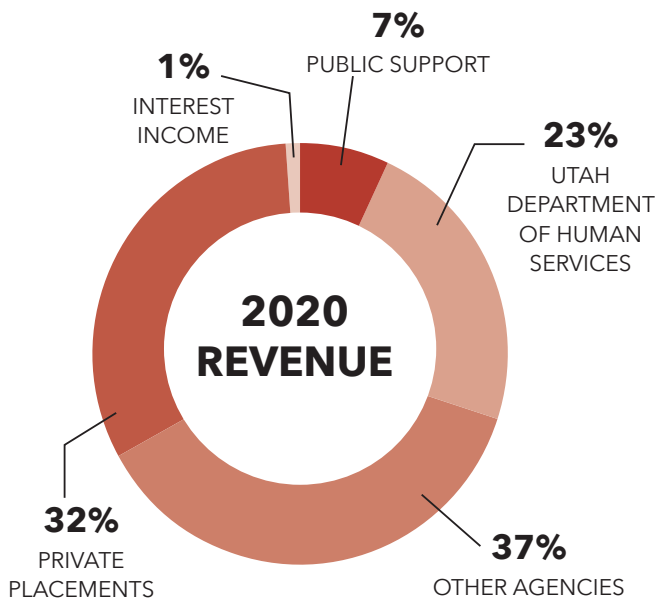


FAMILY HOMES AND TREATMENT FOSTER CARE

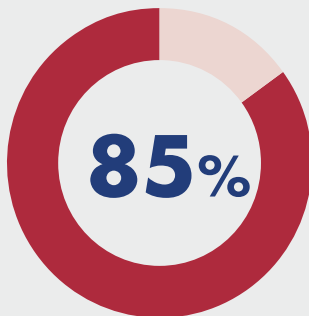

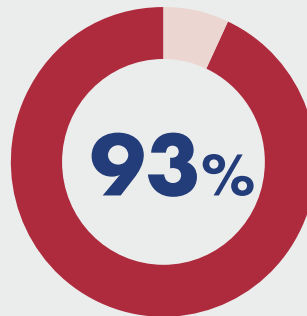
